

RESOLUTION NO. 61-61

BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
CALLING AN ELECTION ON THE PROPOSITIONS OF THE ISSUANCE
OF VARIOUS BONDS OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas,
deems it advisable to issue the bonds of said City for the purposes
hereinafter mentioned:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

1. That an election be held in said City of Mesquite, Texas,
on the 16th day of December, 1961, at which election the following
propositions shall be submitted:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas,
be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the
amount of \$4,600,000.00, maturing serially in such
installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the
maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35)
years from their date, and bearing interest at a
rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to
levy ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such
City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues
and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at
maturity, for the purpose of improving the streets of
said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws
of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 2

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas,
be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the
amount of \$200,000.00, maturing serially in such install-
ments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum
maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from
their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to ex-
ceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy ad valorem
taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient
to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking
fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of
constructing and permanently equipping an addition to
the City Hall of said City, as authorized by the Consti-
tution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 3

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$350,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of constructing and permanently equipping Fire Stations for said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 4

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$125,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of constructing and permanently equipping a public building to be used as a warehouse and maintenance garage for said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 5

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$5,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of constructing and permanently equipping a public building to be used as an animal shelter for said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 6

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$165,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy

ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of constructing and permanently equipping a Public Library for said City, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 7

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$2,135,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, and bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, and to levy ad valorem taxes on the taxable property in such City sufficient to pay the interest as it accrues and provide a sinking fund to pay said bonds at maturity, for the purpose of purchasing and improving lands for park purposes, as authorized by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas."

PROPOSITION NO. 8

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$2,670,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, for the purpose of improving and extending the City's Waterworks System, to be issued in accordance with and secured in the manner provided in Articles 1111-1113, both inclusive, of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended and supplemented, each bond to be conditioned that the holder thereof shall never have the right to demand payment of said obligation out of funds raised or to be raised by taxation, secured by a pledge of the net revenues derived from the City's Waterworks and Sewer System."

PROPOSITION NO. 9

"Shall the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said City in the amount of \$1,750,000.00, maturing serially in such installments as may be fixed by the City Council, the maximum

maturity being not more than Thirty-Five (35) years from their date, bearing interest at a rate not to exceed Six percent (6%) per annum, for the purpose of improving and extending the City's Sewer System, to be issued in accordance with and secured in the manner provided in Articles 1111-1118, both inclusive, of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended and supplemented, each bond to be conditioned that the holder thereof shall never have the right to demand payment of said obligation out of funds raised or to be raised by taxation, secured by a pledge of the net revenues derived from the City's Waterworks and Sewer System."

2. That said election shall be held at the two voting places in said City, as follows, to-wit:

(a) at the Central Fire Station, 320 South Galloway, Mesquite, Texas, with the following named persons as officers of said election, to-wit:

3. That said election shall be held under the provisions of Chapter 1, Title 22, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, and the Texas Election Code, as amended, and only resident, qualified electors who own taxable property in said City and who have duly rendered the same for taxation, shall be qualified to vote:

PROPOSITION NO. 9

AND EXTENSION REVENUE BONDS"
"AGAINST THE ISSUANCE OF SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT
AND EXTENSION REVENUE BONDS"


5. A substantial copy of this resolution signed by the Mayor of said City and attested by the City Secretary shall serve as proper Notice of said election. Notice shall be given in accordance with Article 704, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended. Said notice shall be posted at the City Hall and at the two voting places hereinbefore named for said election, not less than fifteen days prior

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
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to the date fixed for holding said election. Said notice shall also be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published within the City of Mesquite, Texas. The date of the first publication of said notice shall be not less than fourteen days prior to the date set for said election.
