

ORDER CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE
ELECTION OF THREE COUNCILMEN

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 15th day of January, 1962, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Mesquite passed the following Order:

IT IS ORDERED that an election be held in the City of Mesquite on the 3th day of April, 1962 for the purpose of electing three (3) City Councilmen for Place Nos. 3, 4 and 5. Candidates for Place Nos. 3 and 4 must have resided in District Nos. 3 and 4 respectively, as heretofore established by Ordinance, for a period of 120 days next preceding the election date.

Voting shall take place at Polling Place No. 1, being located at Fire Station No. 1 at 320 S. Galloway Street and at Polling Place No. 2, being located at Fire Station No. 2, 4609 Sarazen Drive. The Polls shall be open from 7:00A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

All qualified voters residing in County Election Precincts Nos. 231, 245 and 254 shall vote at Polling Place No. 1. All qualified voters residing in County Election Precincts No. 211 and 252 shall vote at Polling Place No. 2.

Said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas, the Statutes of the State of Texas, and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Mesquite, and shall be in conformity with the procedures set forth herein.

The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Councilman for each Place shall be elected Councilman for that Place for which he is a candidate. In the event any candidate does not receive a majority of the votes cast for a particular office and a run-off election is necessary, said run-off election shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Mesquite.


None but legally qualified voters of the City shall be entitled to vote at said election.

Notice of such election shall be posted in three (3) public places within the limits of the City at least twenty (20) days before the election day. A certified copy of this order shall be attached to said notice and made a part thereof.

A return of such posting shall be made by the affidavit of the City Secretary. Fred Williams is hereby appointed Presiding Judge of Polling Place No. 1, and Isaac Abernathy is hereby appointed Presiding Election Judge of Polling Place No. 2 to conduct said election and they shall appoint such other judges and clerks as may be necessary to assist them in the holding of said election. All of such judges and clerks shall be qualified voters in the City. After the holding of said election, the Election Judges shall promptly make their return to the City Secretary and the Secretary shall thereafter present such returns to the City Council for the canvassing of said election. The Election Judges and Clerks may be paid for their services in an amount to be determined by the City Council.
