WHEREAS, it is the belief of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas that such a Department of Urban Affairs and Housing would not enhance the efficiency, stature or position of the Government of the City of Mesquite;

MOM, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas formally expresses its opposition to the creation of a United States Department of Urban Affairs and Housing; and

HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to each member of the Congressional Delegation of the State of Texas, and that they be urged to use their influence and vote to defeat the proposal to create a Department of Urban Affairs and Howaing.
