

CANVASS OF THE RETURNS AND DECLARATION  
OF THE RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN  
THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON APRIL 3, 1962,  
FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE COUNCILMEN.

BE IT REMEMBERED that on the 3rd day of April, 1962, at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, a quorum being present, the meeting was called to order and the following business was transacted:

Upon motion of Councilman Boyce, and seconded by Councilman Schulz it was unanimously ordered that the City Council consider the official returns of an election in said City held on the 3rd day of April, 1962, for the election of three City Councilmen.

WHEREUPON, said official returns were opened, examined, canvassed, and the results declared as follows:

CANVASS OF RETURNS AND DECLARATION OF RESULTS:

WHEREAS, heretofore B. W. Cruce, Jr., Mayor, called an election to be held in the City of Mesquite on April 3, 1962, for the purpose of electing City Councilmen for Places Nos. 3, 4 and 5, who shall serve for the term of two years (2) commencing April, 1962, and until their successors shall have qualified and taken office, and caused notice thereof to be posted in the manner and for the time provided by law which order, together with notice issued thereon is recorded in Volume 2, page 26, of Resolution Book of the City of Mesquite, and is hereby referred to and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council as follows, to-wit:

Said returns being duly made according to law and duly authenticated, and it being shown that written notices of said election were posted for the time and in the manner provided by law, and all papers pertaining thereto having been returned and filed with the City Secretary and the City Council, and no protest or objection being made to or regarding any matter pertaining to said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That after examining said returns and opening and canvassing the votes cast in said election, that the results of said election were as follows:

It appearing that Perry Masterson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Councilman, Place No. 3, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1962, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that Robert W. Robinson received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Councilman, Place No. 4, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1962, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.



Mann received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Councilman, Place No. 5, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1962, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It is further ordered that this Canvass and Declaration of the results of said election be entered in the minutes of the City Council of the City of Mesquite, and said officers after they have qualified and taken their oaths shall serve during their respective terms of office commencing April, 1962, and thereafter until their successors are duly elected and qualified.


