RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE,

WHEREAS, a Board of Adjustment has been created under the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance and the Statutes of the State of Texas, appeals to the Board of Adjustment may be taken by any person aggrieved or by any officer, department, board or department of municipality affected by any decision of the administrative office; and


WHEREAS, the City Council deems it necessary to fix a fee for the filing of all such appeals to provide for the costs of publication of notices as required by law; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


Section 1. That any person deciding to appeal some administrative decision to the Board of Adjustment under the provisions of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Mesquite, shall be charged a fee of Ten (\$10.00) dollars for each such appeal, and that said fee shall accompany the notice of appeal in order to pay for all costs of publication of notices, as provided for by law.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
