## RESOLUTION NO. 45-62

WHEREAS, the more than one million citizens of Dallas County, as well as the entire population of the Trinity River basin, have long sought the comprehensive development of the Trinity River and its tributaries, and

WHEREAS, Dallas County represents the largest concentration of population in the United States without the benefits of water transportation, and

WHEREAS, Dailas County represents one of the most dynamic growth areas in the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Army Corps of Engineers has developed a comprehensive development program embracing the Trinity River and its tributaries which will provide (1) barge navigation from Galveston Bay to Ft. Worth, (2) flood control, (3) facilities for water quality control pollution alleviation, and (4) reservoirs for municipal and industrial water supplies;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That the Mesquite City Council strongly endorses the comprehensive survey report and urges the Board of Engineers for River and Harbors to take favorable action upon the report at the earliest possible
