

RESOLUTION NO. 7-63
 CANVASS OF THE RETURNS AND
 DECLARATION OF THE RESULTS
 OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE
 CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON
 APRIL 2, 1963, FOR THE ELECTION
 OF A MAYOR AND THREE COUNCILMEN.



It appearing that George Boyce received a majority of the votes cast for the Office of Councilman, Place No. 6, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1963, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

THAT this Resolution declaring the results of the election held April 2, 1963, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
