WHEREAS, Governor John Connally suffers from the wounds of an assassin, and


WHEREAS, he suffers from the loss of the late President, John F. Kennedy, and


WHEREAS, he suffers from the embarrassment and shame of the tragedy occurring in our own beloved State of Texas, and
