

RESOLUTION NO. 15-64
CANVASS OF THE RETURNS AND
DECLARATION OF THE RESULTS
OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON
APRIL 7, 1964, FOR THE
ELECTION OF COUNCILMEN
FOR PLACES 3, 4 AND 5




