

RESOLUTION NO. 17-64
 CANVASS OF THE RETURN
 AND DECLARATION OF THE
 RESULTS OF AN ELECTION
 HELD IN THE CITY OF
 MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON
 APRIL 21, 1964, FOR
 THE ELECTION OF CITY
 COUNCILMAN, PLACE 5

WHEREAS, a Run-Off Election was held on April 21, 1964 for the purpose of electing Councilman for Place 5 for a term of two years;

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of election held April 21, 1964, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held April 21, 1964, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
