

RESOLUTION NO. 17-65
 CANVASS OF THE RETURNS AND
 DECLARATION OF THE RESULTS
 OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE
 CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ON
 APRIL 20, 1965, FOR THE
 ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND A
 COUNCILMAN FOR PLACE 6

WHEREAS, a City Run-Off Election was held on April 20, 1965, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and a Councilman for Place 6 for a term of two years;

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of election held April 20, 1965, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

B. J. Smith	<u>796</u>


It appearing that George Boyce received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Mayor, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1965, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.



Motley received a majority of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 6, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office for a term of two (2) years, after qualifying, and shall commence in April, 1965, and continue until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.
