

RESOLUTION NO. 26-65

WHEREAS, the United States of America has heretofore made an advance, pursuant to an agreement dated March 12, 1946 to the City of Mesquite, Texas, in the amount of \$525.00 for the purpose of plan preparation of the public work described in the agreement as "Additions to Existing Water System" under Project No. Tex. 41-P-286, and

WHEREAS, by the use of the Federal advance the City of Mesquite, Texas, caused to be prepared plans and specifications for the public work described in the aforesaid agreement, and


WHEREAS, no construction has been undertaken of the project or any portion thereof described in the aforesaid agreement dated as of the 12th day of March, 1946, and


WHEREAS, there is no reasonable likelihood of the planned project or any portion thereof being undertaken because of changes in the City's development pattern;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, that as there is no reasonable likelihood of the project or any portion thereof as planned with the Federal advance ever being placed under construction for the reasons set forth above, the Housing and Home Finance Administrator be requested to make a determination that the agreement dated on the 12th day of March, 1946 be terminated and that the City of Mesquite be relieved of all liability thereunder.

This resolution is adopted pursuant to the authority provided by the Home Rule Charter of the City of Mesquite, Texas.
