The advertisement shall run one time each week for two weeks, and the bids shall be received not earlier than fourteen (14) days from the late of the first publication. All bids shall be received subject to the terms and provisions of the Charter of the City of Mesquite, and shall be filled with the City Secretary on the date and hours specified and shall be opened and read in the presence of the Council in a public meeting of the City Council.

SECTION 3. The City Council, in initiating this proceeding, is acting under the terms and provisions of the Act passed at the First Called Session of the Fortieth Legislature of the State of Texas, and known as Chapter 106 of the Acts of said Session, together with any amendments thereto, now shown as Article 1105b of Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, which said law, as an alternative method for the construction of street improvements in the City of Masquite, Texas, has been adopted and made a part of the Charter of said City, being Section 12, Article III of said Charter.
