

## RESOLUTION NO. 46-65

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on September 25, 1965 for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

FOR the adoption of the Firemen's and  
Policemen's Civil Service Act; or

AGAINST the adoption of the Firemen's and  
Policemen's Civil Service Act;

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of election held September 25, 1965, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

It appearing that a majority of the votes were cast for the adoption of the Firemen's and Policemen's Civil Service Act and such Act, known as Article 1269m of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, be and the same is hereby declared to be in effect in the City of Mesquite thirty days after the beginning of the first fiscal year of the City after the said election.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held September 25, 1965 shall become effective immediately after its passage.
