

CITY OF MESQUITE
RESOLUTION NO. 5-67

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT A CENTER BARRIER
MEDIAN BE INCLUDED WHEN STATE HIGHWAY 352 IS
CONSTRUCTED FROM SAM HOUSTON ROAD TO A POINT
EAST OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 635

WHEREAS, the Texas Highway Department has passed
Minute Order No. 56849 with reference to the improvements
in Dallas County, Texas, on S. H. 352 from East of Loop 12
to Carmack Street in Mesquite, a distance of approximately
4.0 miles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite approved and accepted
Minute Order No. 56849 by Council resolution by the City
of Mesquite, December 6, 1965.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That it is understood and agreed that as
part of the proposed improvement on this project it is the
specific request of the City of Mesquite that a center barrier
median will be constructed from Sam Houston Road to a point
east of I. H. 635 with openings to be provided only at dedi-
cated street locations and at specific locations in accordance
with the proposed plans for construction.

Section 2. That the City Secretary shall certify a
sufficient number of copies of this resolution and the City
Manager is hereby authorized to forward two certified copies
thereof to the Commissioners Court of Dallas County for such
action as they may deem proper.
