RESOLUTION NO. 12-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 10-67 TO CORRECT THE RETURNS OF THE CITY ELECTION HELD APRIL 1, 1967.

WHEREAS, there was a great difference in the number of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 6, and the office of Mayor in the election held April 1, 1967; and

WHEREAS, the Council requested a recount of the votes cast in said election under the provisions of Article 7.14, Sections 19 and 20 of the Election Code; and

WHEREAS, District Court Judge Dallas Blankenship and County Judge W. L. "Lew" Sterrett recounted the votes cast in said election and found discrepancies in the number of votes shown on the voting machines and the number of votes shown on the election returns at Polling Place No. 1--320 South Galloway; and

WHEREAS, it was the concensus of opinion that the mistakes in the returns were made due to poor lighting and the difficulty in reading the numbers on the voting machines;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas:

THAT Resolution No. 10-67 be amended to show the returns of the City election held April 1, 1967 be corrected to read as follows:
