

RESOLUTION NO. 13-67
 CANVASS OF THE RETURNS
 AND DECLARATION OF THE
 RESULTS OF A RUN-OFF ELECTION HELD IN THE
 CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS
 ON APRIL 15, 1967
 FOR THE ELECTION OF A
 MAYOR AND COUNCILMAN, PLACE 6

WHEREAS a City election was held on April 15, 1967 for the purpose of electing a Mayor and a Councilman, Place 6 for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of election held April 15, 1967, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

It appearing that George Boyce received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Mayor he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two years, commencing April, 1967, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that Bob Beard received a majority of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 6, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying for a term of two years, commencing April, 1967, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


