
WHEREAS city planning is recognized to be of primary importance for the further growth and development of the City of Mesquite, and


WHEREAS the Texas State Department of Health can arrange for the needed planning and can arrange for the financial assistance from Federal sources,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Mesquite, Texas, requests the Texas State Department of Health to arrange for the following planning services: Comprehensive Master Community Plan and to arrange for financial assistance in the sum of \$54,940.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Mesquite will make available upon the request of the Texas State Department of Health the sum of \$30,210 to aid in defraying cost of the requested stated planning service.
