

RESOLUTION NO. 41-68

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the projected growth trends of the City of Mesquite necessitate that the Master Plan of the City be updated; and,

WHEREAS, to accomplish an updating and revision of the Master Plan of the City of Mesquite, a portion of the expenditure therein involved need be borne by Federal participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract on behalf of the City of Mesquite; wherein Howard, Needles, Tammen & Bergendoff shall be retained in the capacity of consultant for the purposes of updating and revising the Master Plan of the City of Mesquite; and the Texas State Department of Health shall be a third party to the contract acting in the capacity of "Planning Assistance Agency."

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage.
