

RESOLUTION NO. 4-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, TO AMEND THE PAVING AND DRAINAGE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE TO ESTABLISH A REQUIREMENT FOR LIME STABILIZATION OF SUBGRADE MATERIAL IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite did, by Resolution No. 11-62, dated April 16, 1962, establish certain requirements for the construction of drainage facilities and pavement of public streets, highways, alleys and other public places; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did deem it necessary to amend said specifications by Resolution No. 24-63, dated July 15, 1963, and by Resolution 42-64, dated December 21, 1964; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now deems it necessary to amend said specifications further;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Paving and Drainage Specifications of the City of Mesquite are hereby amended, establishing a requirement for lime stabilization of subgrade material in the construction of public streets and alleys, in accordance with revised Section 208, "Subgrade", of said specifications, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 2. That from and after the adoption of this Resolution, all plans and specifications for the construction of public streets and alleys submitted to the City of Mesquite for approval shall conform to the revised specifications referred to above.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its date of passage.
