

RESOLUTION NO. 7-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT A PUBLIC HEARING BE CALLED FOR THE 20TH DAY OF APRIL, 1970, TO DISCUSS THE IMPROVEMENT OF TOWN EAST BOULEVARD AND THE ASSESSMENT OF ABUTTING PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, finds it necessary to improve Town East Boulevard for a distance of approximately twenty-five hundred feet (2500') east from Interstate Highway No. 635, and

WHEREAS, such improvements will consist of widening, paving, curbing and guttering, up to ninety percent (90%) of the cost of which shall be assessed against the abutting property owners, and


WHEREAS, a public hearing should be held to discuss the improvements to Town East Boulevard and the enhancement in value to the abutting properties caused thereby.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That a public hearing is hereby called for the 20th day of April, 1970 to discuss the improvement of Town East Boulevard and the assessment of abutting properties enhanced thereby as hereinabove setforth.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage.


