

RESOLUTION NO. 8-70
CANVASS OF THE RETURNS
AND DECLARATION OF THE
RESULTS OF AN ELECTION HELD IN THE
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS
ON APRIL 4, 1970
FOR THE ELECTION OF
COUNCILMEN FOR PLACES 1, 3, 4 AND 5

It appearing that C. G. "Chip" MacLelland received a majority of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 3, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1970, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


It appearing that Don H. Cook received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilman, Place 4, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1970, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that B. J. Smith received a majority of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 5, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1970, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held April 4, 1970, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
