RESOLUTION NO. 10-70  
CANVASS OF THE RETURNS  
AND DECLARATION OF THE  
RESULTS OF A RUN-OFF ELECTION HELD IN THE  
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS  
ON APRIL 18, 1970  
FOR THE ELECTION OF A  
COUNCILMAN, PLACE 1

WHEREAS, a Run-off election was held on April 18, 1970, for the purpose of electing a Councilman for Place 1; and

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

THAT after examining said returns of election held April 18, 1970, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

Sharp received a majority of votes cast for the office of Councilman, Place 1, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve, after qualifying, for a term of one year, commencing April, 1970, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held April 18, 1970, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
