A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, INCREASING THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE SEMESTER HOURS AS A PREREQUISITE TO EMPLOYMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER FROM 30 TO 60.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That no applicant for the position of police officer of the City of Mesquite shall be considered unless such applicant shall have successfully completed at least 60 college semester hours.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage.
