BEGINNING at a point in the Northwest line of Mesquite Valley Road on the West line of Rutherford Park Estates No. 3, an addition to the City of Mesquite, Texas;

THENCE North 01° 00' East, with the West line of said Rutherford Park Estates No. 3, 545.00 feet;

THENCE North 30° 30' West, with the West line of said Rutherford Park Estates No. 3, 34.10 feet;

THENCE North 62° 00' West, with the West line of said Rutherford Park Estates No. 3, 24.89 feet;

THENCE South 01° 00' West, 591.00 feet to the beginning of a curve to the right whose radius is 80.00 feet;
