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RESOLUTION NO. 30-70

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE NECESSITY OF IMPROVEMENTS CONSISTING OF A DRAINAGE CHANNEL, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY MANAGER, ALONG THE WEST FORK OF SOUTH MESQUITE CREEK, KNOWN LOCALLY AS THE CORRIGAN-ROFFINO DITCH, BETWEEN ANTHONY DRIVE AND U. S. HIGHWAY 80, IN THE CITY OF MESQUITE, AND THE TERRITORY SPECIALLY BENEFITED THEREBY, ON NOVEMBER 16, 1970.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That a public hearing be had on November 16, 1970, for the purpose of determining the necessity of improvements consisting of a drainage channel, as recommended by the City Manager, along the West Fork of South Mesquite Creek, known locally as the Corrigan-Roffino Ditch, between Anthony Drive and U. S. Highway 80, in the City of Mesquite, and the territory specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 2. The fact that the drainage improvements and works are necessary for adequate protection to the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite, Texas, constitutes an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens and requires that this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said resolution, as the law in such cases provides.
