RESOLUTION NO. 4-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING PASSAGE OF AN ORDINANCE SETTING LOCAL TELEPHONE RATES AND IMPOSING A FRANCHISE FEE; PROVIDING THE TIME AND LOCATION THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That a public hearing be called on March 15, 1971, at 2:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 711 North Galloway, Mesquite, Texas, for the purpose of considering passage of an ordinance setting local telephone rates and imposing a franchise fee for use of City streets by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company.

SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
