RESOLUTION NO. 9-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING ITS SUPPORT OF SENATE BILLS 292 THROUGH 301 AND FOR STATE AID TO THE DEAF.

WHEREAS, certain citizens have requested that the City Council express its support for State aid for the deaf and particularly Senate Bills 292 - 301; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that said Senate Bills, if passed, will be in the interest of the people of the City of Mesquite and this area generally;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby express its support of Senate Bills 292 through 301 and for State aid to the deaf.

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be furnished to the members of the Legislature from Dallas County.


SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and Charter in such cases provide, and it is so resolved.
