RESOLUTION NO. 17-71

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RESCINDING THE ACTION TAKEN AT THE COUNCIL MEETING OF MAY 17, 1971, AND APPOINTING CERTAIN PERSONS AS MEMBERS AND ALTERNATES TO THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION; PROVIDING THAT SUCH APPOINTMENTS TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the action taken at the regular Council meeting of May 17, 1971, in appointing Don Harper and David Cote to the Board of Equalization be and the same is hereby in all things rescinded and such appointments shall be of no effect.

SECTION 2. That the following persons are hereby appointed to the Board of Equalization as members and alternates as follows:

SECTION 3. That these appointments take effect immediately.

SECTION 4. The fact that the time for hearing appeals before the Board of Equalization has heretofore been set for June 7-11, 1971, and the fact that a sufficient number of members to such Board have not been appointed creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this resolution take effect immediately upon its passage.
