RESOLUTION NO. 24-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION OF THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR A FEDERAL GRANT FOR MAKING A SYSTEMS ANALYSIS STUDY AND REGIONAL PLAN FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FOR THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS REGION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments is authorized by law to conduct such coordinating and technical studies as may be required to guide the unified, far-reaching development of the area, eliminate duplication, and promote economy and efficiency through areawide planning; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments has prepared an application for a Federal grant under Section 206, Title II, PL 89-272, Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended, to obtain funds for making a Systems Analysis Study and Regional Plan for Solid Waste Disposal for the North Central Texas Region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has been asked to participate in the program and to share in the local cost of the study in the amount proportionate to the 1970 population distribution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Prospectus for work to be accomplished under the proposed Systems Analysis Study and Regional Plan for Solid Waste Disposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESOLITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby supports the application of the North Central Texas Council of Governments for a Federal grant for making a Systems Analysis Study and Regional Plan for Solid Waste Disposal for the North Central Texas Region and pledges its proportionate share not to exceed \$3,450.00, which proportionate share was based on the 1970 population distribution, said amount payable over two (2) fiscal years.

SECTION 2. That the City of Mesquite requests the United States Government to approve the application, as submitted by the North Central Texas Council of Governments, in order that a comprehensive plan for solid waste disposal may be developed for the North Central Texas Region.
