
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING  
A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE  
THE CITY OF MESQUITE IN REQUESTING FOR A GRANT FROM  
THE STATE OF TEXAS PARK AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to develop park land  
to adequately serve the recreation needs of the citizens of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, the financing of these park developments has become a great  
burden upon the City of Mesquite and financial assistance is being requested  
to develop a community park (Paschall Tract);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of  
Mesquite, Texas, that Billy York, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible  
Officer and Bill Avery, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal  
Officer, for the purpose of requesting, receiving and dispersing Federal  
Funds through the State of Texas Parks and Wildlife Department as provided in  
the Land and Water Conservation Program in Public Law 88-578 entitled "The  
Land and Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965"
