RESOLUTION NO. 41-71

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DECLARING A MORATORIUM ON ENFORCEMENT OF SECTION 13-9.01 OF THE CITY CODE AND AUTHORIZING A STUDY OF CONDITIONS RELATING TO STORAGE OF CAMPERS AND TRAVEL TRAILERS USED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City Council that certain problems exist with respect to the parking and storage of campers and travel trailers used for recreational purposes, and;

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that a study be made with regard to conditions existing in this area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That a moratorium is declared as to enforcement of Section 13-9.01 of the Code of the City of Mesquite for a period of sixty (60) days as same relates to the parking and storage of campers and travel trailers used for recreational purposes, (not including units used for living purposes), and the City Manager is authorized to cause a study to be made regarding the conditions and problems in this area to aid the Council in making a proper determination of this matter.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution take effect from and after the date of passage as provided by law.
