

RESOLUTION NO. 20-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CALLING A PUBLIC HEARING ON AUGUST 21, 1972, AT 2:30 P.M., IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 711 NORTH GALLOWAY, MESQUITE, TEXAS, TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A PROJECT WHEREIN A SANITARY SEWER OUTFALL LINE WILL BE CONSTRUCTED THROUGH SAMUELL PARK, A PUBLIC PARK OF THE CITY OF DALLAS, TEXAS, LOCATED ON U. S. HIGHWAY 80, AND ADJOINING THE CITY OF MESQUITE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a permanent easement and a working easement be acquired through SamuellsPark; and

WHEREAS, Article 5421q, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes requires that a public hearing be held to determine the necessity therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a public hearing be held August 21, 1972, at 2:30 P.M., in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 711 North Galloway, Mesquite, Texas, to consider approval of a project wherein a sanitary sewer outfall line is to be constructed through Samuells Park, a public park in the City of Dallas, Texas, located on U. S. Highway 80, and adjoining the City of Mesquite. Said sanitary sewer line is to be constructed underground through a permanent easement, with an additional temporary working easement during construction.

At such hearing it shall be determined whether or not:

- (1) there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use or taking of such land;
- (2) such program or project includes all reasonable planning to minimize harm to such land as a park and recreation area resulting from such taking;
- (3) that clearly enunciated local preferences have been considered.


