

RESOLUTION NO. 25-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REQUESTING THAT THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT INSTALL LIGHTING ON HIGHWAY 80 AND INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 30 AT THE EXPENSE OF THE STATE WITH OPERATING COSTS TO BE PAID BY THE CITY OF MESQUITE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT EFFECTING SAME, AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAME.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby request that the State Highway Department install lighting on Highway 80 and Highway 30, from the East to the West City limits of the City of Mesquite, with the State assuming the total cost of installation and the City assuming the operating costs thereof.


SECTION 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the State Highway Department to effect same.
