RESOLUTION NO. 31-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR POLICE TELETYPE EQUIPMENT TO BE PURCHASED THROUGH A FEDERAL GRANT ADMINISTERED BY THE TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL; AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO PURCHASE SUCH EQUIPMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; PROVIDING THAT COST OF PARTICIPATION NOT EXCEED \$3,000.00; AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite is endeavoring to establish improved Mesquite Police Services to serve the needs of the citizens of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, the financing of teletype equipment would place a burden upon the City of Mesquite and financial assistance is being requested for the purchase of this badly needed equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby authorize the North Central Texas Council of Governments to advertise for bids for police teletype equipment to be purchased through a Federal Grant administered by the Texas Criminal Justice Council, and the North Central Texas Council of Governments is hereby authorized to purchase such equipment on behalf of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 2. That participation in the cost of said teletype equipment is hereby authorized in the amount not to exceed \$3,000.00.
