RESOLUTION NO. 34-72


A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING AND NAMING A CITY OF MESQUITE PARKSITE, CONSISTING OF 46.445 ACRES OF LAND OUT OF THE J. DAVIS SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 421, LOCATED ON NEW MARKET ROAD WEST OF WALKER STREET, AS PASCHALL PARK; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Parksite consisting of 46.445 acres of land out of the J. Davis Survey, Abstract No. 421, and located on New Market Road west of Walker Street, is hereby designated and named Paschall Park.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its date of passage.
