A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO SOLICIT BIDS ON THE CITY'S BEHALF IN CONNECTION WITH THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE GRANT FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE REGIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has been advised by the North Central Texas Council of Governments of a Criminal Justice Grant with regards to regional law enforcement communications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite by this resolution authorizes the North Central Texas Council of Governments to solicit bids on its behalf in connection with the Criminal Justice Grant for participation in the regional law enforcement communications system for the acquisition of police inter-city radio communication equipment and communication console equipment.

SECTION 2. That bids pertaining to the share of the City of Mesquite in this regional law enforcement communications system are subject to final approval of a budget reflecting such amount and under no condition or circumstances does this agreement in any way constitute an obligation of the City of Mesquite, and being further subject to the provision that this program is a part of the federal grant and any payments herein are contingent upon the availability of said federal funds.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately after its passage as the charter in such cases provides.
