A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DESIGNATING A RESPONSIBLE OFFICER AND A FISCAL OFFICER TO SERVE THE CITY OF MESQUITE FOR REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE TEXAS CRIMINAL JUSTICE COUNCIL AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFOR.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Billy G. York, City Manager, is hereby designated Responsible Officer and William J. Avery, Director of Finance, is hereby designated Fiscal Officer for the purpose of requesting, receiving and dispersing Federal Funds through the Texas Criminal Justice Council under the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, Public Law 90-351, as amended by the Omnibus Crime Control Act of 1970, Public Law 91-644.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
