A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING AND RECOMMENDING TO THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF DALLAS COUNTY THE GENERAL DESIGN OF THE BELT LINE ROAD - SOUTH GALLOWAY INTERSECTION KNOWN AS PLAN "A" AS SHOWN BY THE ATTACHED PLAT AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the design of the proposed Belt Line Road - South Galloway intersection and the traffic flow pattern to be established is of vital interest to the City of Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has given serious consideration to this question;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:



SECTION 2. That this resolution take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.

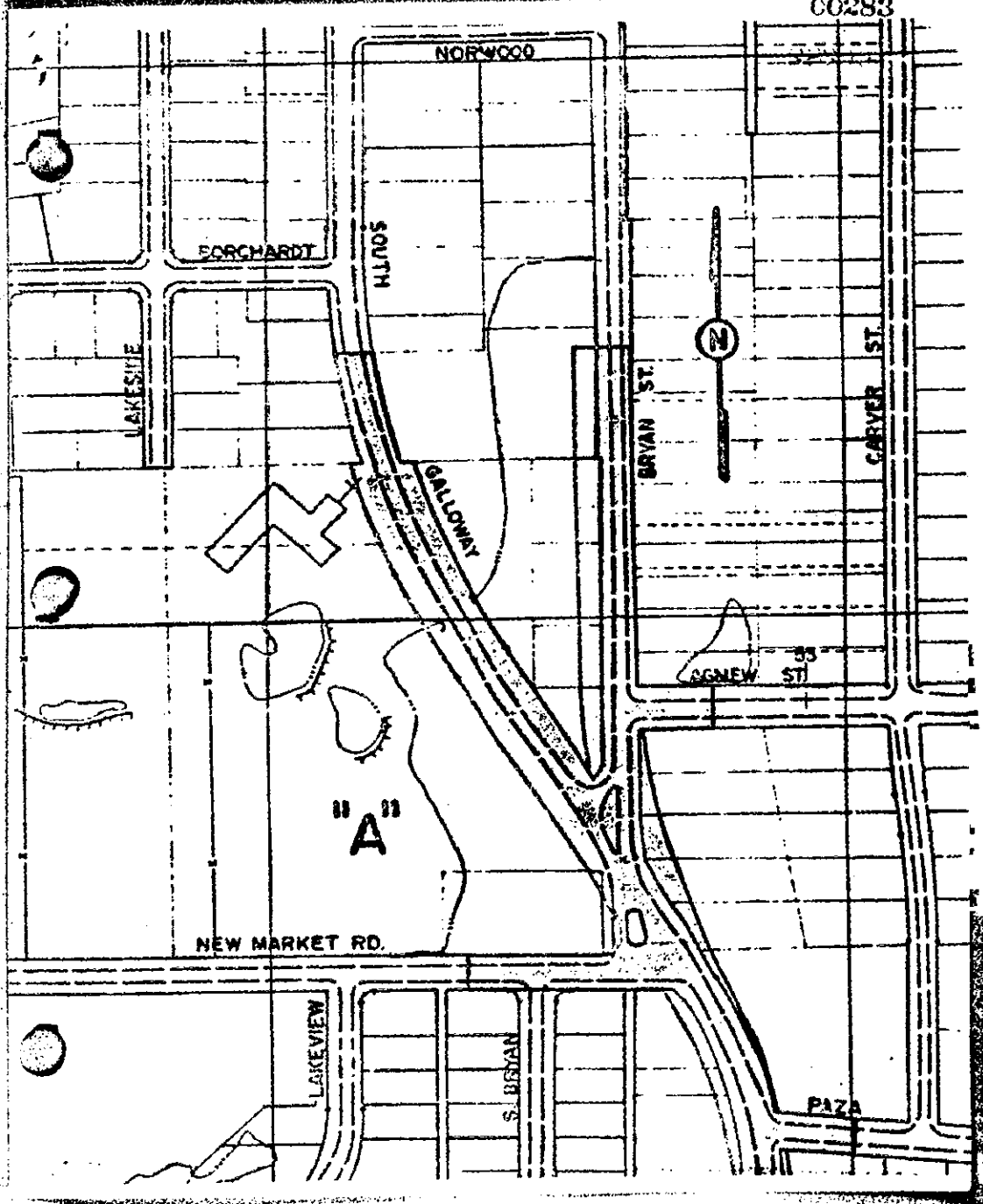
