RESOLUTION NO. 4-73

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING THEIR THANKFULNESS FOR THE RELEASE OF LIEUTENANT COLONEL ART ELLIOTT AND OTHER RELEASED PRISONERS OF WAR AND EXPRESSING SYMPATHY AND CONDOLENCES FOR THE FAMILIES OF MAJOR EDWIN L. ATTABERRY AND OTHERS WHO GAVE THEIR LIVES FOR THEIR COUNTRY, AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 2. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, further express their condolences and sympathy to the families of Major Edwin L. Attaberry and other prisoners of war who gave their lives for their Country and express their hope that the memory of those who made sacrificies will enhance the prospects of a lasting peace.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}.$ That this resolution take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
