RESOLUTION NO. 5-73

WHEREAS, a Special Election was held on February 3, 1973 for the purpose of voting on the following proposition:

FOR the proposed minimum salary of \$785.00
per month for Policemen;

AGAINST the proposed minimum salary of \$785.00
per month for Policemen;

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judges and other officers holding said election made their returns of the results thereof to the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That after examining said returns of election held February 3, 1973, and canvassing the votes cast in said election, the results of said election are declared to be as follows:

THAT the following number of votes were cast for the following proposition:

NUMBER OF VOTES

FOR 1004 AGAINST 496

"A minimum salary of \$785.00 per month for Policemen."

It appearing that a majority of the votes were cast for the adoption of the minimum salary of \$785.00 per month for policemen, the proposition is hereby determined to have carried.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held February 3, 1973 shall become effective immediately after its passage.
