A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AGREEING TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF A SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT FROM THE CITY OF DALLAS, TEXAS, WITH CERTAIN STIPULATIONS AND INCLUDING THE WAIVER OF PRO RATA CHARGES UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has determined the necessity for a Sanitary Sewer Easement through Samuell-East Park, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas has requested certain services in connection with the City of Dallas' use of such land for park purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, does hereby agree to accept an easement from the City of Dallas, Texas, for the North Mesquite Sanitary Sewer Outfall Line through Samuell-East Park with the following stipulations:

- That pro rata charges on all land within Samuell-East Park be waived;
- That three domestic sewer taps be provided for the residence and comfort stations;
- That the Superintendent of Samuell-East Park be alerted prior to any construction and that every effort be made to save trees;
- 4. That the City of Dallas be invited to make an inspection of the project through the Park prior to final payment to the contractor.
