## RESOLUTION NO. 8-73

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE SUIT TO REMOVE THE CEMETERY DESIGNATION FROM A PORTION OF FROST CEMETERY AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the County of Dallas has made arrangements to acquire a portion of Frost Cemetery for Belt Line Road Rightof-Way and has caused any graves in said area to be removed through action of the County Judge; and

WHEREAS, no graves exist in said area; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dallas has requested the assistance of the City of Mesquite in removing the cemetery designation thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the dedication of the land described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto for cemetery purposes is not needed for cemetery purposes.

SECTION 2. That the City Attorney is hereby authorized to institute suit in the appropriate court to have the cemetery dedication from said land removed.

SECTION 3. That this resolution take effect immediately upon date of passage as the law in such cases provides.
