Sharp received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilman, Place 1, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1973, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.


It appearing that Emitt Evans received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilman, Place 2, he is hereby declared to be elected to said office to serve after qualifying, for a term of two (2) years, commencing April, 1973, and until his successor shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

It appearing that no candidate received a majority of votes cast for the Office of Councilman, Place 6, it is necessary to call a run-off election to be held April 21, 1973, for the purpose of deciding between Vernie G. Erwin and J. B. Galloway for the Office of Councilman, Place 6.

THAT this resolution declaring the results of the election held April 7, 1973, shall become effective immediately after its passage.
