WHEREAS, by a resolution heretofore passed by the City Council of the City of Mesquite, the following streets and alleys:

- Braden Street from Walker Street to New Market Road,
- Sandy Lane from Hickory Tree to Powell Road, Alley between Derby and Danbury from Military
- Parkway to Scyene Road, Alley west of San Marcus from Laurel Lane to
- LaPrada Drive

shall be improved by paving; and,


WHEREAS, by the terms of said resolution, specifications were ordered to be made by the Director of Public Works, for the improvement of said streets and alleys as provided by said resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the said specifications have been prepared and are now submitted to the City Council for approval and adoption; Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

SECTION 1. That the specifications so presented to the City Council of the City of Mesquite by the Director of Public Works and prepared by him for the improvements of said street and alleys enumerated above, as hereinbefore defined, having been carefully considered by the City Council, be, and the same are hereby approved and adopted as the specifications for the improvement of the said streets and alleys.

SECTION 2. That the City Secretary be, and she is hereby instructed to advertise for sealed bids for the construction of the improvements called for by this resoludescribed for the improvements called for by this resolution, such advertisement for bids to be published in the Mesquite Daily News, the official publication of the City of Mesquite, which is a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Mesquite. The advertisement shall run one time each task for the works and the bids chall be received not week for two weeks, and the bids shall be received not earlier than fourteen (14) days from the date of the first publication. All bids shall be received subject to the terms and provisions of the Charter of the City of Mesquite, and shall be filed with the City Secretary on the date and hours specified and shall be opened and read in the presence of the Council in a public meeting of the City Council.



SECTION 3. The City Council, in initiating this proceeding, is acting under the terms and provisions of the Act passed at the First Called Session of the Fortieth Legislature of the State of Texas, and known as Chapter 106 of the Acts of said Session, together with any amendments thereto, now shown as Article 1105b of Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, which said law, as an alternative method for the construction of street improvements in the City of Mesquite, Texas, has been adopted and made a part of the Charter of said City, being Section 12, Article III of said Charter.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage, as in the Charter in such cases is made and provided.
