RESOLUTION NO. 6-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, STATING THE POSITION OF THE CITY COUNCIL ON PROVISIONS OF THE PROPOSED STATE CONSTITUTION AFFECTING MUNICIPALITIES OF THE STATE, AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the revision of the Constitution of the State of Texas is of vital concern to the municipalities of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Municipal League has adopted a comprehensive review and recommendation of the proposals affecting municipal governments with alternate proposals where indicated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Mesquite generally endorses and approves the position adopted by the Texas Municipal League by the delegates on the floor at their annual convention and particularly the proposed language to the effect that in the event a county government is given ordinance powers and in the event an ordinance of a county and an ordinance of a city conflict, the ordinance of a home rule city shall prevail.

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be furnished to The Honorable Price Daniel, Jr., President of the Constitutional Convention, and the members of the Legislature from this District.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
