RESOLUTION NO. 17-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS CONCURRING WITH THE DESIGNATION OF THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS AS THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR TRANSPORTATION PLANNING IN THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS REGION.

WHEREAS, Section 112 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973 (Public Law 93-87) requires the states to designate metropolitan planning organizations in urbanized areas to receive apportionment of planning funds for transportation planning; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Dolph Briscoe, Governor of Texas, did, by letter dated April 12, 1974, to Bob Beard, Mayor, City of Mesquite, designate the North Central Texas Council of Governments as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments has been actively engaged in transportation planning for a period exceeding four years and, with the local governments and the Texas Highway Department, has developed meaningful transportation plans for the North Central Texas Region,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby concurs with the designation of the North Central Texas Council of Governments as the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Area under the conditions stated in the designation by the Governor of the State of Texas.


SECTION 2. That the City of Mesquite recognizes the importance of its active professional participation in transportation planning activities and hereby indicates its desire to participate actively in the transportation planning process for North Central Texas.

SECTION 3. That this motion shall be in effect immediately upon its adoption.
