## RESOLUTION NO. 27-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DEEMING IT NECESSARY TO APPLY FOR A FEDERAL GRANT FOR MAKING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SOUTH MESQUITE SANITARY SEWER OUTFALL AND EXPANSION OF THE CITY WASTE-WATER RECLAMATION PLANT AND DESIGNATING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE RESPONSIBLE OFFICER FOR SUCH PURPOSE AND PROVIDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mesquite, Texas, deems it necessary and proper to apply for a federal grant under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, Public Law 92-500, and the rules and regulations pursuant thereto for the purpose of making certain improvements in the South Mesquite Creek Sanitary Sewer Outfall Outfall and the expansion of the City Waste-Water Reclamation Plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Billy G. York, City Manager, or his successor, is hereby authorized and directed to make application for a grant under Public Law 92-500 and the rules and regulations pursuant thereto, and to sign the acceptance of the grant, when made, and any other necessary documents required to complete the project on behalf of the above named applicant.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
