RESOLUTION NO. 34-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING AN AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION TO ASSIST IN THE CELEBRATION PLANS OF THE STATE AND OF THE NATION; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest of the City of Mesquite to participate in the Bicentennial Celebration of our Nation; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint a local Commission to formulate plans for the local celebration and to coordinate the City's plans with those of the State and National Celebration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That an American Revolution Bicentennial Commission is hereby established, consisting of a Chairman, two (2) ex officio members and twelve (12) Commissioners.

SECTION 2. It is further resolved that the membership shall consist of the persons and positions as shown on the attached Exhibit "A".


SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon date of passage as the Charter in such cases provides.
