RESOLUTION NO. 16-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUPPORTING THE PROPOSAL OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION OF MESQUITE FOR THE CITY OF MESQUITE TO PERMIT AND SUPPORT A PLAN OF PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY SQUARE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS WILL BE ONE OF THE PROJECTS BY WHICH THE CITY OF MESQUITE CELEBRATES THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION BICENTENNIAL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


